

Completing our inaugural North American Private Equity Fund and a Continuation Vehicle

In February, we achieved a milestone for Investcorp's North American Private Equity business with the final close on our inaugural fund ("NAPE Fund I") with \$1.2 billion of total commitments. Concurrent with the completion of NAPE Fund I, we closed on a continuation vehicle with three of our 2016 vintage assets totaling approximately \$300mm of value. We currently have nine portfolio companies in NAPE Fund I and 14 portfolio companies overall (see page 13 for a high-level summary of each of our portfolio companies).





Investcorp's North America Private Equity team has been investing in North American mid-market businesses for over 40 years. We are among the most active global mid-market private equity firms. Since inception, we have completed more than 70 transactions in North America, deploying almost \$23 billion in transaction value.

We invest in mid-sized, business services companies in large, growing and resilient sectors, led by strong management teams with prominent industry positioning and strong prospects for growth supported by strong cash flows and high returns on invested capital. The majority of our investments are in founder-led and / or family-owned businesses.

Our transaction opportunities include buyouts and corporate carve-outs. We invest in controlling stakes and substantial minority investments.

Post-investment, we act as a strategic partner to our CEOs and executive teams, utilizing the best internal and external resources to accelerate company growth and equity value creation.

Our investment team is supported by a network of actively engaged Advisory Directors and Independent Board Directors who work with our investment team and portfolio companies. Investcorp's Advisory Directors and Independent Board Directors are seasoned CEOs and C-level executives who have worked in major enterprises and have highly successful track records in their respective fields, with expertise in areas that directly align with Investcorp's verticals and specific value creation initiatives to support portfolio companies.
